Mary's Update



Dear Prayer Warriors,

This past summer (June to August), I spent time training my coworkers, Ping and Benz. We had a wonderful time together in the Word of God. I am so thankful to the Lord for the way He has prepared both of them to work alongside me in our women's ministry. I want you to hear from their hearts what our women's ministry means to them personally:

Ping "As soon as I was introduced to the Women's Ministry in Thailand, I knew that it was God's will for me to be involved there for as I listened to Chanaddah teach the Word, my heart hungered for more of God's Word. His Word showed me that we are to be blameless by living in holiness and



faithfulness and so I committed myself to meditation, prayer, recitation and the study of His Word. The more I did that, the more I wanted God and the less I wanted the things of this world. Also, it became clear to me that God wants His faithful people to teach in order to make disciples of all the nations. Just as I hungered for God's Word, I want to see Thai women also hunger for His Word. I want them to take God's Word seriously, strive in their walk with our Holy God, fear Him such that they seek His will (and not man's) and be part of the greatest commandment to the nations." Benz "In Thailand, the truth of God's Word is being severely compromised because there are many places where it is not being accurately taught. People are mistakenly following signs, miracles and a prosperity gospel. I was once like them, professing to be Christian while compromising on the precepts of Scripture. However, due to the sound doctrine being taught at the Women's Ministry in Thailand, I have not only accepted Christ as my Lord and Savior but am prayerfully, faithfully and obediently abiding in Him in my spiritual walk. Now, I would like to see other Thai women studying God's Word accurately so that their lives could also be transformed to glorify God."

CDs One of my goals is to consistently produce new teaching series on CDs for our women's ministry. This is to meet the spiritual needs of those that faithfully follow the CDs. I thank God for His Truth and faithfulness in expanding His Kingdom via this ministry."



Sirilux She is from a Thai speaking church and works full time as a secretary at one of the well known hospitals in Bangkok. She finds that the teachings on CDs is a main source of her spiritual growth.

"I am so grateful to the Lord for the teachings of the Women's Ministry in Thailand that are available on CDs. They have caused my spiritual eyes and ears to be opened to more accurately understand Scripture, leading to a more loving and peaceful relationship within my family and a hunger to read Scripture. Ping, Benz and I are trusting that over the next few years, God will raise up many faithful women to be taught and trained to become true disciples of Jesus, reaching many in Thailand.
