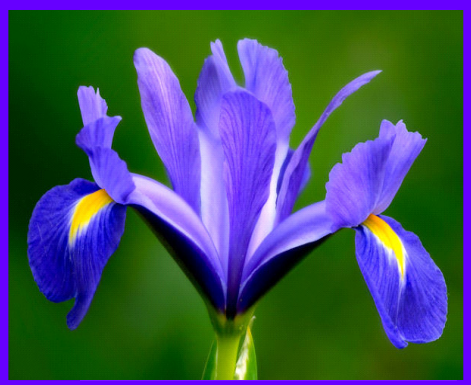

Mary's Update



Dear Praying Friends,

Four months of teaching in Chiang Rai has gone by so quickly. I hope to finish the course by the end of March. By God's grace, I have been able to fly back and forth between Bangkok and Chiang Rai weekly. I also have been taking the time to lay a solid foundation of teaching to a small discipleship group in Bangkok. This past December, these women came to me with a spiritual hunger, and they continue to absorb everything I teach for three hours every Saturday. Physically, I am exhausted, but spiritually I am so encouraged to see God at work. Many lives have been transformed. You might like to hear from some of them:

Women in Bangkok

Lah: “I used to focus on money and possessions, but today I understand that God and His Word are more precious than anything else in this world. My true desire is to make my life count for eternity and I hope to join the women's ministry after my retirement which is at the end of 2017. In fact, my husband has come to know Christ through observing my transformed life.”

Yao: “I went to church for 17 years, but never understood how to live a Christian life. Just recently, I have begun to understand the Scriptures and am experiencing inner peace and have become aware of sins in my daily walk.”

Mee: “I was living in sin in different areas of my life for ten years, but now my spiritual eyes have been opened through weekly Bible study. Today, I see sin as sin and am quick to repent; I am learning to abide in Christ.”



Women in Chiang Rai

“I understand God's plan and will for me as a woman a lot better. At last, I am able to search my own heart and realize how much I need to change in order to be a blessing to my family.”
