Last month, I spent three days teaching a group of Akha tribe women in Chiang Rai. I was very encouraged to see their eagerness to learn and to grow in the knowledge of the Word. Since then, I have started praying that if it is God's will, by next year, I would like to spend more time teaching and training certain women in Chiang-Rai as the door is wide open for me.
