Dear Prayer Warriors,

While Sarah planned the first women's retreat for the Lahu tribe this past April, she hoped to see about 50 women show up. However, it turned out that over 80 women arrived from different Nazarene churches in Chiang Mai, Thailand.

When I saw those women eagerly and attentively absorbed in the Word of God during the retreat, I stood in awe of God. Their response made their husbands (who were taking care of the children) marvel at their wives' hunger for the Word. Their husbands told me that they had never seen anything like that before.

I taught three long sessions each day...morning, afternoon, and evening...for three full days. When the retreat was over, the women did not want

to go home because they wanted more from the Word! I praise God for such a wonderful response to the topic of "God's Will for Women." Many of them shared and cried with joy over the things they had learned. They recognized their sins and repented. They felt convicted that they had sinned against their husbands in many ways, and could not wait to seek their husbands' forgiveness. To me, that was a true sign of revival! God was certainly in our midst. To God be the glory.

As the retreat ended, a youth pastor approached me, after hearing a wonderful report from his wife. He thanked me and booked me to be a guest speaker for their youth camp in April of next year! Another exciting thing is that his wife started using the lessons I taught at the retreat, with the women in her church. Many women are glad to have my teaching available on YouTube!

I have teaching opportunities scheduled for the rest of the year, both at home and in other places. August 20-26 (for seven full days), I am scheduled to teach the wives of church leaders in a neighboring country. It's best not to mention the name of the country. Those key women are burned out and need help spiritually.

October 9-11, I will be a guest speaker at a women's camp in northeast Thailand. They normally have about 300 women who come together from many churches and provinces.

At the time of this writing, I am in Harrisonburg, Virginia, for eye treatment and dental care.



God has provided me with free treatments in this part of the world, and I see this as God's goodness and provision towards me. I am here for just a short time and will return home as soon as the treatments are over. Please continue to pray for healing upon my eyesight.

Last, but not least, I am asking for special prayer towards fund raising. I need a 75% increase in
