Dear Prayer Warriors,

I am excited to report to you about my recent teaching trip in Laos. I taught for 35 hours over seven days on the topic, "God's Will for Women". Nineteen women were invited; most of them were full-time workers at rehab centers. Although the teaching sessions were long each day, none of them complained nor fell asleep. They all paid close attention to the teaching and responded with a hunger for it. They confessed that they had never been taught the Word of God in such a practical way before. As a result, their lack of Scriptural knowledge and understanding had led them to live in sin. Now, they are convinced that discipleship is God's will for them, and that they need to spend time in the Word and in prayer daily.

Some women were at their wits end and planned to divorce their husbands but once the teaching began, the Holy Spirit moved in their hearts and convicted them of their sin. By the end of each day, they all mourned over their sins, and repented of them. There was a man who had discouraged his wife from attending the

conference but by the fourth day, he was amazed to see his wife weep over her sins and seek his forgiveness. The highlight of this past conference was that the wives sought forgiveness from their husbands and reconciled

with them. As the conference ended, I saw the husbands drive over to pick up their wives with joy and gladness. Hallelujah!

However, victory and spoils do not come without trusting in God wholeheartedly while fighting against the fierce enemy! There were obstacles and challenges trying to prevent the conference from happening. Discouragement and exhaustion hit me hard but God was my strength. On the third night, I had a nightmare after praying against evil spirits that possessed a woman. Pon had suffered with a demonic possession for several months, and no one could set her free. Five occult doctors died, one after another, from trying to help her. Finally, a couple from a rehab center took her in, and ministered to her through the Word of God and prayer for two weeks. Then, she was brought to the conference to listen to my teaching for seven days!
