Dear Praying Friends,

My heart is filled with praise and adoration for God because I have received more letters from prisoners, testifying to the transformation which has taken place in their lives after having read the book, “Knowing the One True God”. Let us continue to give praise to our great God who has done this marvelous work inside the Thai prisons. I remember ten years ago trying very hard to get permission to preach the Good News in prisons, but it was impossible. Now that my book has been published, God, in His perfect timing, has made it possible for my book, which presents the Gospel very clearly, to get into the hands of prisoners across Thailand. To God be the glory!



This past June, I had a second printing done for 6,000 copies; and I distributed them to different prison ministry teams across Thailand. In the back of my mind, I was thinking, “Now the books should last them for at least a year, and I can just move forward with my sabbatical rest.” So, I set off for the USA on July 26 and started to have a relaxing time. Less than two weeks later, I was contacted by Dr. Buakab, the leader of an organization named “Every Home for Christ in

Thailand”. It works with 25 prisons in the northern part of Thailand. She told me that the book was very good and the pastors liked it a lot. She was adamant that they would need 3,000 more copies for new believers inside the prisons. I was shocked with excitement! I praise our faithful God for this great opportunity.

I believe that they probably need more than 3,000 copies for 25 prisons, but were hesitant to ask for more. Knowing I had already spent all the donation money on the second printing, I thought, "What a good problem to have!" I love this kind of problem because it causes me to lean on God who is all-powerful. With great excitement, I continue to look to God, our Provider, who called me to this ministry.

With God's help, in one week, Ping (my co-worker) and I were able to create a video regarding the work of the Thailand Prison Ministry. We did this to inform others about God's great work among prisoners and to ask for prayers and financial support. Some of you have seen the video and have been very encouraged by it. Guess what? Over the last four weeks, God raised up just enough financial support (through your kind donations) for another printing of 6,000 copies. At the time of this writing, the printing has been completed and the books have been transported to Chiangmai and Bangkok. Thank you for standing by me in supporting this wonderful work. I am encouraged by your generosity. 😊 I have been informed that since the beginning of this year, the books have been given to prisoners in 74 prisons across the country. The whole country has 140 prisons with approximately 340,000 prisoners.

I recently had my testimony, titled "The Wonders of God's Protective Hands" printed into pamphlets. Miraculously, God has allowed it to reach many people in the US, including 200 copies that have been sent to a jail in Collin County, Texas! Please pray for more opportunities to share my book and pamphlet in Texas and elsewhere.
