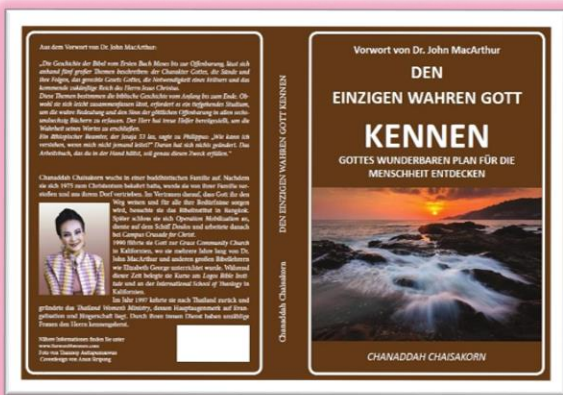


“And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed.”

Dear Praying Friends,

It has been a long while since I last communicated with you because I have been struggling with poor health. Last May (2024), just before my trip to visit my supporting church in Germany, I had a very hard fall on a cement floor, which caused an issue with my left toe, making me limp for three months. Even now, my left toe is still not quite normal. Anyhow, while I was in Europe, my only brother passed away, and that caused me much sadness as I was not able to see him before his passing. However, I trust that he is now in the presence of our Savior.

Since last August, I have been recuperating from pain in various parts of my body and feeling very frail. Despite my poor health, God has helped me raise funds and print 10,000 more copies of my book to meet the spiritual needs of prisoners throughout Thailand. Now, over these past four weeks, I have felt a lot better, but the condition of my right eye is still poor.



Let us rejoice that my book written in the German language was published this past December and is available in Europe. Praise God for Dr. Georg Huber's hard work in translating it. Please pray that the Lord uses this book in a mighty way to reach German-speaking people.

The encouraging news is that this past November, God opened up an opportunity whereby 273 copies of my book were given to prisoners in Brunswick County, North Carolina. Shortly after that, a prisoner named

Randall Chandler, who was a Muslim, gave his life to the Lord after reading the book. We rejoice with him and praise God for his new life in Christ. Upon his request, some of us were able to provide him with a study Bible and concordance, as he has begun teaching the Word of God to his fellow inmates!

My long-time friend and faithful supporter, Betty Ann McClung, lives in North Carolina. She has been working hard to make contact with prison officials as well as chaplain trainers so that the books can reach prisoners in different parts of the U.S. Although she is not young physically, she has always been active in witnessing and very passionate for the lost. I am grateful to have her as my partner in reaching out to prisoners in the U.S. Please keep her in your prayers.



Since I am trusting God to reach prisoners across the U.S. through the book "Knowing the One True God", please pray that God will raise up an organization in the U.S. that would be willing to partner with me in printing my books free of charge, so that I can make them available to prisoners without limitation. I know this is a very challenging prayer request, but let's look up to our great God for the impossible, because we serve the Almighty God who is able to do all things. (Luke 1:37)



This past December, Brian and Susan Fletcher, my faithful supporters, were able to visit me and my country, and we had a wonderful time of fellowship together. This couple loves scuba diving and is very adventurous!

Last summer, I had a great time visiting Susan and Ludwig Braun, my supporters who live in France. Then, this past January, they came to visit Thailand and me! They certainly had a great time touring around Thailand and visiting Ludwig's longtime friend.
