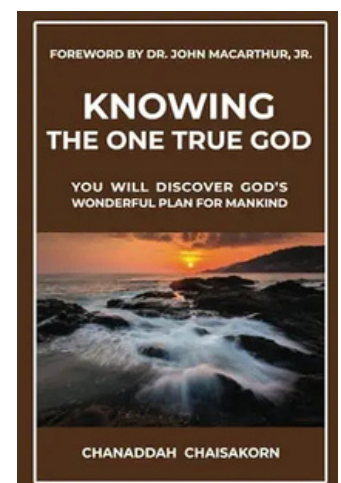

Dear Praying Friends,

It has been almost a year since I last communicated through newsletter. Since last Fall, I have been going through rough and tough roads with health problems and not being able to function as normal in many ways. Let me share with you in detail so that you can direct your prayer toward me more specifically.

Last September, somehow an insect got inside my ear. The doctor at the ER was trying to do his job but failed to find the insect and turned around telling me that there was no insect and that it was my own imagination! On top of that, he accidentally poked my inner ear, which caused the bleeding and a little wound. I changed doctors and he was able to find an insect and removed it in no time! Shortly after that an infection started to take place deep inside the ear and this was followed by lots of fungus. I suffered with much pain day and night and I could not function nor sleep. I cried out to the Lord and He led me to the right ear specialist, and he was able to give me the right treatment. Within one week my ear was completely healed. Praise be to our merciful God.

I was feeling good for just two weeks, then on December 5<sup>th</sup>, I stumbled and fell hard on the road while in a hurry. The fall resulted in a bad wound on my left knee and a bone fracture on my right hand. I had to wear a cast for six weeks. I could not help myself with only one hand and one good leg and had to depend on other people's help in many areas for two full months. Since January 22<sup>nd</sup>, I have been going for physical therapy and massage therapy for the restoration of my fingers and hand. It has been seven months now and yet the healing is still very slow.



Recently I started going for acupuncture also and it seems to help quite a bit. It has been hard not being able to use my right hand because of its stiffness and also the pain in my right arm. As a result of it, most of my work has been on halt except for my discipleship group, pictured below. Regardless of the circumstances, I thank the Lord for allowing me to go through these trials for a reason. Since I have been seeing different doctors, each one of them has received my book, "Knowing the One True God." Somehow my bone doctor is paying close attention to what he reads in my book. I certainly believe that God's word will not return void.

Despite going through pain and hard times, I find that God's grace has been sufficient because I manage to teach the word of God to the women in discipleship group weekly through Zoom. It's encouraging to see them grow in their spiritual walk with God and their lives continue to change for the better. I give praise and honor to our faithful God.

As far as my books are concerned, they have gone out to about 100 jails, prisons, and detention centers across Thailand. Certainly, many of them came to know the Lord and have changed lives. In the US, my books have also gone out to several jails and detentions center in 9 different states. I hope to share more in detail in my next newsletter the way God has been using this book in the lives of Thai prisoners. I continue to look up to God for more doors to open in Thailand, especially among those who are in different walks of life.

Please keep me in your prayers for a full restoration of my right hand as I continue going for different kinds of therapy five days a week. Your prayers and faithful support mean so much to me. Thank you very much for your loving care as well as your prayers.
